Tom Demmer is State Representative for the 90th District in the Illinois House of Representatives, which includes parts of DeKalb, LaSalle, Lee, and Ogle Counties in north central Illinois.

Tom is Deputy Minority Leader in the Illinois House of Representatives and the chief budget negotiator for the House Republican Caucus. He is a strong voice for transparency, reform, and fiscal responsibility in state government. Since elected in 2012, Tom has led efforts to consolidate and streamline state agencies, established oversight measures to hold government accountable and fought for common sense budget reforms to reduce the burden on Illinois families.

Tom Demmer is Director of Innovation & Strategy at KSB Hospital, a not-for-profit community hospital with locations in Lee and Ogle Counties. In this role, he conducts service line analyses, monitors market share data, and leads efforts in establishing organizational strategic plans and community health needs assessments. He is a member of the senior leadership team and works to analyze healthcare industry trends and set organizational strategy.

Tom graduated from the University of Dayton with a degree in communications, and was a White House Intern in domestic policy for the Office of the Vice President of the United States in 2006. Tom is a Henry W. Toll Fellow with the Council of State Governments. He served on the Board of Directors of the Ronald Reagan Boyhood Home Preservation Foundation. He is a member of St. Anne Parish and is a volunteer teacher on business and ethics with Junior Achievement.
