Recap: Financial Impact Analysis of Elimination of Cash Bail

- In September 2021, the Illinois Supreme Court/AOIC & Civic Federation released a report on the Financial Impact of the Elimination of Cash Bail
 - 5 years of data: 2016-2020
 - Included total bond payments collected and disbursed
 - Received data from 96 counties (excluded 6 small counties: Kankakee, Knox, Fulton, McDonough, Hancock and Henderson)
- Bond payments collected and applied (i.e., processed and distributed) with specific breakdowns about how applied bonds were distributed
 - Fees
 - Fines
 - Restitution
 - Refunds



Summary of Revisions to September 2021 Report


- Corrected data:
 - Total bond applied number in 2020 for Champaign County
 - Bond Processing Fees and Other Clerks' fee categories for Sangamon County
- Addition of Lee County (not included in original report)
- Added additional detail for county-level fees for: Will County, McLean County and DuPage County
- Recategorized a small number of fees for a handful of counties
- Statewide totals did not change significantly



Total Bond Payments Applied in Illinois






Bond Processing Fees Received by Circuit Court Clerks in Illinois

- Incomplete data
- Missing fields
- Different terminology
- Potential errors/misclassifications
- Changes in data entry/fields used over time
- In 77 counties using the PC Jims system, bond processing fees were recorded with other clerks' fees prior to CTAA, so the numbers are likely inflated by 10-20%
 - Across all the counties the difference was calculated to be only about 4%
- **Numbers should be considered <u>estimates</u>






- Includes 95 counties (missing Cook and the same 6 small counties excluded from original report: Kankakee Knox, Fulton, McDonough, Hancock and Henderson)
- Data presented slightly differently than 2016-2020 to better show distribution of bond payments across key uses:
 - Fees
 - Fines
 - Restitution
 - Refunds/Payments to Attorneys
- Includes breakdowns of fees applied to:
 - Bond processing fees
 - Other Circuit Clerk Fees
 - Other County Fees (fees used to support county functions)
 - Fees to all other agencies (e.g. State of Illinois, municipalities, other local governments)

Distribution of Total Bond Payments Applied in Illinois: 2021 n = 95 Counties




- Fees: 47%
- Fines: 10%
- Restitution: 3%
- Refunds/Payments to Attorneys: 39%

Distribution of Bond Payments Applied to Fees in Illinois: 2021 n = 95 Counties




Note: Components parts do not add to Total Fees Applied from Bond because three counties (Sangamon, St. Clair and Tazewell) were not able to provide detailed breakdowns of bond payments applied specifically to Other Circuit Clerk Fees, Other County Fees and Other Agency Fees. For those counties, bonds applied to fees are grouped together and included in the Total Fees Applied from Bond category.

- Fees to Counties: 57%
 - Bond processing fees
 - Other Circuit Clerk Fees
 - Other County Fees
- Fees to All Other Agencies: 39%
- Note: not all counties
 provided information
 allowing for fee
 breakdown by agency
 type, so their total fee
 allocations are included
 in total.












Example of Total Bond Distribution: Will County
