n 1894 a group led by several of Chicago's most prominent citizens – including Jane Addams, Bertha Honoré Palmer and Lyman J. Gage – coalesced around the need to address the city's economic, political and moral climate. The resulting organization, called the Civic Federation, evolved during the 20th century to become a leading advocate for governmental fiscal responsibility and rational tax policy.

Now over a century old, the Civic Federation remains true to its founding members' non-partisan mission. That mission is to work with Chicago-area governmental bodies to help them reduce their costs and improve the quality of government services. The Civic Federation:

- Promotes opportunities to reform local tax structures;
- Guards against the wasteful expenditure of public funds; and
- Serves as a technical resource for public officials and opinion leaders through non-partisan tax and fiscal research.

Recent Civic Federation efforts have brought international attention to the State of Illinois' fiscal crisis and successfully promoted the need for public pension reform across the state. More locally, the Federation continues to be a respected and outspoken advocate for reforming the Cook County property tax system and campaigns for increased fiscal responsibility and transparency among all governments.

The Civic Federation established the annual awards luncheon 30 years ago to recognize and pay collective tribute to the extraordinary civic contributions of Chicago-area citizens and institutions. Thank you for helping the Civic Federation continue its vital mission in the 21st century.
